HIV Situation in Armenia



- 1988 First case of HIV in Armenia
- 2021 HIV prevalence is estimated at 0.2%
- The estimated number of the people living with HIV (PLHIV) 4800
- HIV incidence per 1000 population 0.19
- Deaths due to AIDS < 100.

Armenia is the first country in the European region, which proved to have eliminated <u>mother-to-child</u> HIV transmission.

Males constitute a major part (69%) in the total number of HIV cases. In 2020, about 51% of PLHIV was in the age group of 25–39 at the time of HIV diagnosis. **The main modes of HIV transmission** are through heterosexual contacts (72%) and injecting drug use (20%), followed by male-to-male sex, accounting for 4.4% of all registered cases.
